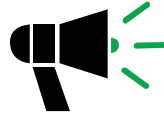

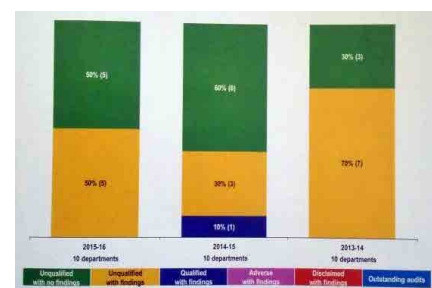
ANC-LED GAUTENG GOVERNMENT PRIORITIZING DISASTER-HIT AREAS
